Day: 1 Delhi – Nainital (330 km / 7 hours)

Drive to Nainital (330 kms/7 hours from Delhi). Nainital is a town in the Indian state of Uttarakhand and headquarters of Nainital district in the Kumaon foothills of the outer Himalayas. Situated at an altitude of 1,938 meters (6,358 feet) above sea level, Nainital is set in a valley containing a pear-shaped lake, approximately two miles in circumference, and surrounded by mountains, of which the highest are Naina (2,615 m (8,579 ft.)) on the north, Deopatha (2,438 m (7,999 ft.)) on the west, and Ayarpatha (2,278 m (7,474 ft.) on the south. Check in at a hotel. Evening free for leisure. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day: 2 Nainital

Morning after breakfast proceeds on a local tour of Nainital visiting the Naina Devi Temple and Hanuman Garhi. Spend the rest of the day at leisure or enjoy a boat ride in the Naini Lake (boats can be hired directly) or take the ropeway to see accumulated snow (on direct payment basis). We recommend a visit to snow view by means of a Gondola (ropeway) from where you will get the most spectacular view of the snow-capped peaks (ticket for Gondolo ride on direct payment). Overnight at Hotel

Day: 3 Nainital

After breakfast proceed for an excursion trip to Bhimtal (Bhimtal: (1371 Mt) About 22 Kms from Nainital, Nestled in a Beautiful Pristine Valley, This Jem of a Lake Is the Largest around Nainital. The Beauty Is Enhanced By A Small Island Surrounded By Crystal Blue Water), Naukuchia Tal and Saat Tal. And Back To Hotel, Night Stay At Hotel, If You Are In Tested For 3kms Trek For Tiffin Top, Tiffin Top: (2290 Mt) Also Known As Dorothy's Seat -In Memory Of An English Lady Mrs. Kellet Dorothy, Who Was Killed In An Air Crash Tiffin Top Is A Short Trek Of About 3 Kms From Nainital And Provides Excellent View Of The Himalayas And The Town.

Day: 4 Nainital – Binsar (95 kms / 3 hours)

After breakfast depart for Binsar. Binsar is a frequently visited hilly station from different parts of the world. This gorgeous and lovely place is circled by dense forests. This region is also known as Bineswar, which was constructed by the King Kalyan. The majestic beauty of Binsar ia the

wonderful view of Mighty Himalayas from zero point. Individuals can overview the snowcapped mountains such as Kedarnath, chaukhamba, Trishul, Nanda Devi, Nanda Kot etc, and can breathe the fresh and calm air there. This place is far far away from the noisy crowed of the modern cities. Those who are searching for places to spend some moments in the lap of solitude can head straight to Binsar

Binsar must watch places of attractions include visit to Golu Devta Temple-The Golu Devta temple is home to the deity that is very popular all over kumaon and 4 km froiem Binsar. Pariyadeva Pashan- It is believed that the hills of binsar are a reservoir of ancient relice. Zero Point-Located within the binsar Wildlife Santuary, this is the place Where one can get a glimpse of 300 km panoramic view of the Himalayan Mountains such as kedarnath, Shivling, Trishul and Nanda Devi. Khali Estate-Set Amidst the Binsar Sanctuary is the khali estate-a 26 acre of serene and beautiful land. Binsar Wildlife Sanctury Is home of 200 Species of bird barking, Deer, Himalayan Bear, leapord, fox, musk deer, langur, porcupine, flying squirrel, chital, jungle car etc. Bineshwar Mahadev Temple-It is a famous temple dedicated to lord Shiva. Bineshwar is the major crowd Pullet of Binsar. Overnight at Binsar

Day: 5 Binsar – Kausani – Binsar (60 km one way)

Full Day excursion trip to Kausani. Kausani is popular by the name of Valna, a Himalayan hilly town sited in Uttarakhand state. Kausani, situated in Almora district, is located at an altitude of 6075 ft above the sea level. It is a much loved tourist destination for its natural beauty and scenic views of mighty Himalayas.

Viewers can receive visuals of many other mountains including Trishul, Nandakot, Nanda Devi etc. Mahatma Gandhi, the national father of India, loved this place and called it the Switzerland of India. This increased the popularity of the spot manifolds. Those who visit Uttarakhand can't afford to miss a trip to Kausani.

Every year this Switzerland of Indian attracts tourists, pilgrims and others in large number. This area is in between the pine trees at the top of the ridge. It oversees the Someshwar on one side, Garur and Baijnath Katyuri valley on the other side. In old days was attached with almora District during that period it was under the administration of the Katyuri king, Baichaldeo. After some time passed Baichaldeo gave a large area of this place to a Brahmin Sri, Chand Tiwari as a donation.

The renowned poet Sumitra Nandan Pant was born in Kausani which is also makes it so popular. There is a Museum which was given the name of the poet when Sumitra had left this world and the museum called "Pant Museum". The other memorable location in Kausani talks about the Lakshmi Ashram devoted for social services and for women's welfare.

Return back in the evening. Overnight at Binsar

Day: 6 Binsar – Corbett (165 kms / 4 hours)

Travel by surface to Corbett National Park.

Corbett National park: A promosing land for the world species at Ramnagar in Nainital district in uttarakhand. The Corbett national park is the most dwindling part of nature resising at the himalayal foot hill & Shivalik ranges and is being called as the perfect tigers land. India's first noticed wildlife sanctuary and national park established in the year 1936, brings opportunity to be hold the largest

tigers population in the vicinity. Corbett remains open to mid-October to mid-June; the main reason for closure of the park during the rest of the year is that mansoon make most of the roads get washed away. After mansoon, the repaired work start and it is only by Nov. Those roads are back in motive conditions. On arrival at Corbett transfer to hotel, check in to hotel. Rest of day is free at leisure. Overnight stay at hotel at Corbett.

Day: 7 Corbett

Early morning Visit Corbett National Park (OPTIONAL & TO BE BOOKED IN ADVANCE) and enjoy viewing all the wildlife. Later back to hotel. Rest of the day free at leisure. Overnight stay at hotel at Corbett.
